

MARRIAGE RECORDS

TRINITY ESPISCOPAL CHURCH

The cornerstone of Trinity Church, located at Bush and Gouch streets, San Francisco, California, reads as follows: - "Trinity Church, the First Protestant Episcopal Church on the Pacific Coast; Founded 1849, This edifice erected 1892."

These records are taken from the Church Register which was started in 1853. Where names have been given as witnesses the same have been written in, but where the marriage was public, or where friends were witnesses, and their names not given, that portion of the record has been left blank.
